## SITE NOTICE

Cuilfeach Teoranta is applying for a 10-year planning permission for an amended wind farm development, with an operational life of 30 years from the date of the first commissioning, in lieu of the previously permitted wind farm development [An Bord Pleanála Reference Number: PL 05B.237656]. The amended wind farm shall consist of

- (a) Eight wind turbines with both a Nordex 133 and an Enercon 126 model assessed, with only one type of the identified turbine models to be erected, in the townlands of Graffy, Meenamanragh, and Dalraghan More, Glenties, County Donegal.
- (b) Associated access tracks & hardstands, underground cable connections and peat recovery areas in the townlands of Graffy, Meenamanragh, and Dalraghan More, Glenties, County Donegal.
- (c) A meteorological mast 80m high in the townland of Graffy, Glenties, Co. Donegal.
- (d) A substation and a temporary construction compound in the townland of Meenagrubby Glenties, County Donegal.
- (e) An underground grid connection, circa 7.5kms long, from the proposed substation at Meenagrubby to the Tievebrack electricity station at Drumnalough through the townlands of Meenagrubby, Meenamanragh, Graffy, Banganboy, Stracashel, Meenamalragh, Drumconcoose and Drumnalough, Glenties, County Donegal.
- (f) Road strengthening, verge widening and culvert extensions along the delivery road through the townlands of Lugaveen, Tieveragh, Dalraghan More, Meenamanragh and Graffy and a new road section at Lugaveen, to facilitate deliveries of turbines.

An Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) and a Natura Impact Statement (NIS) will be submitted with the application. The planning application, the Environmental Impact Assessment Report and Natura Impact Statement may be inspected or purchased at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, at the offices of the planning authority during its public opening hours.

A submission or observation in relation to the application may be made in writing to the planning authority on payment of the prescribed fee, €20 within the period of 5 weeks beginning on the date of the receipt by the authority of the application and such submissions or observations will be considered by the planning authority in making a decision on the application. The planning authority may grant permission subject to or without conditions, or may refuse to grant permission.
